Question #9

Does Missouri have a responsibility to those who are exonerated?

- **In Missouri, innocent persons who spend any part of their lives on death row are almost completely overlooked after they are released.**
- **If a person is exonerated through DNA testing he is eligible for some help, but if declared innocent for any other reason, there is no assistance.**
- **When guilty prisoners are released, they are provided with a parole officer who helps them begin life again, assisting with employment and housing. If innocent and exonerated, this assistance is not available.**
